Day 1 Nov. 13 Depart USA to Tel Aviv

Today we depart from the USA to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals served in flight.

Day 2 Nov. 14 Arrive in Tel Aviv

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to our hotel in the Galilee area for check-in, dinner and a good night's sleep.

Day 3 Nov. 15 Sea of Galilee, Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, Tabgha, Boat Ride, Jordan River

Today we explore the area around the **Sea of Galilee**. Travel to **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. Visit the synagogue that stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall His teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matt. 4). Visit the peaceful **Mount of Beatitudes** that overlooks the Sea of Galilee. On this hill, Jesus preached the **Sermon on the Mount** (Matt. 5-7). Stop at **Tabgha**, where the feeding of the 5,000 is remembered at the **Church of the Loaves and Fishes** (Luke 9). With your Bible in hand, cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee aboard a **Kinnereth Sailing Company boat**. Along the way, you will enjoy a special on board worship service. Remember your baptism at the **Yardenit Baptismal site**, where the Jordan River exits the Sea of Galilee on its journey southward (Matthew 3).



Day 4 Nov. 16 Cana, Nazareth, Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Caesarea Maritima

This morning we will recall Jesus' first miracle as we pass through **Cana** (John 2). View **Nazareth**, the boyhood home of Jesus (Matthew 2) from the **Mount of Precipice**, where Luke describes how Jesus was rejected by those in the synagogue after He taught them. Filled with anger they "led Him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast Him down headlong" (Luke 4). Travel the ancient caravan route to **Tel Megiddo** where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Look out over the Valley of Jezreel from the heights of **Mount Carmel**. On this mount, Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Journey to **Caesarea by the Sea** and stand in the place where it is believed Paul addressed King Herod and Festus (Acts 25, 26). This port city reveals many extensive remains of the theater and other sites, including a Roman aqueduct along the Mediterranean shore. Continue to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 Nov. 17 Mt. of Olives, Site of the Ascension, Garden of Gethsemane, Bethlehem

Stand atop the **Mount of Olives** as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of **Jerusalem**. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9 - 12). Visit the **Chapel of the Ascension**. Enter the **Garden of Gethsemane**, where Jesus went to pray after the Last Supper, and was arrested

(Matthew 26). In **Bethlehem** visit the cave where Jesus was born and the church that has been constructed on the site (Matthew 1; Luke 2). Nearby, you will view **Shepherds' Field** where the Good News was first heard.

Day 6 Nov. 18 Upper Room, Caiaphas' House, Pool of Bethesda, Garden Tomb, Gordon's Calvary
Stand in the **Upper Room**, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark 14). Walk through some of the ancient rooms of **Caiaphas' the High Priest's house** beneath the **Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu**. Here, it is believed by many, Jesus was held overnight before His crucifixion (Luke 22). View the Pool of Bethesda (John 5) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Also planned today is a stop at **Gordon's Calvary** where we can sense the agony of Christ's crucifixion and the exhilaration and reality of the resurrection at the **Garden Tomb**. At the end of our time in the Holy Land, we prepare for our return journey to the USA.

Day 7 Nov. 19 Arrive USA

Arrive in the USA with a lifetime of memories to cherish or begin optional extension to Jordan.

If you have ever wanted to see the Holy Lands, now is the time! We would like to invite you to take a trip to Israel November 13th-19th. Going to Israel is an experience of a life time as you get to see and experience where Jesus walked over 2000 years ago.



We will be going to Nazareth, Cana, Sea of Galilee, Mt of Beatitudes, Garden of Gethsemane, Bethlehem etc... Pastor Bryan will be leading this life changing and eye opening trip so make plans to join the Twin Rivers family in experiencing the Holy Lands!

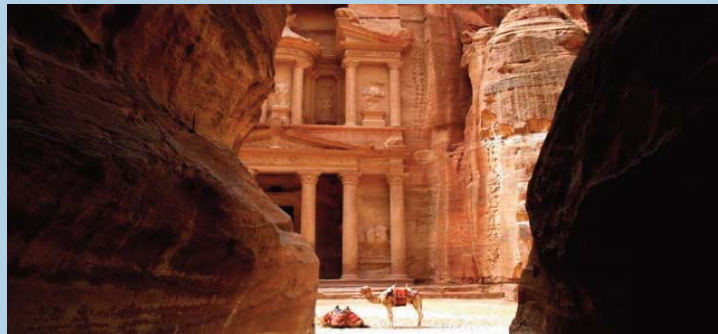
