
WHAT IS FORMULA TWELVE?


FORMULA TWELVE LEAD TEAM BRYAN CUTSHALL, TH.D.

FORMULAS

LEADERSHIP - MAXIMIZING YOUR 15%

Often 85% of every church leader's job description is already determined. This leaves only 15% of their time and energy for leading into the future. This formula will ensure you maximize that 15%.

• VISION - THE 26 DAY LAW

Every church must have a compelling vision. This formula is designed to help every pastor discover the church's unique vision, implement the vision into culture and to develop clear communication goals for the vision.

• OUTREACH - THE 63% TRUTH

The average church attendee has at least 7 significant relationships with unchurched people. 63% of these people say they would attend a church if a friend invited them. This formula will help the pastor develop a strategy to capitalize on this truth.

COMMUNICATION - THE 2+2+2 STRATEGY

Communicating to your congregation is arguably your most significant opportunity to inspire life change in the people of your church. This strategy will help you consider the 2 most important goals of communicating, the 2 types of people in every church audience, and the 2-weeks-ahead method of planning for your communication.

PLANNING - THE PREPARATION> CREATIVITY PARADOX

A church's calendar is a vital indicator of the church's direction and intention. This paradox points to the truth that being prepared always trumps being creative. Creativity is important to church leadership but must always submit to planning and preparation.

EVENTS - THE 1:4 RATIO

Executing a great event is a key element to attracting new people to your church. This ratio demonstrates that every person involved in the execution of an event affects the total attendance and success.

• IMPRESSING GUESTS - THE 7X5 LAW

Guests form their first impression of your church very quickly. This law emphasizes the importance of two concepts: capturing the attention and heart of a guest within their first 7 minutes and making at least 5 contacts with that guest before he/she finds a seat.

CONNECTING GUESTS - THE 48 HOUR WINDOW

Having first time guests in your church is exciting but it isn't the final step of the ministry process. This formula teaches how you can make essential contacts with guests within 48 hours of his/her first visit to your church to ensure that he/she returns.

NEXT STEPS - THE 1/4 GOAL

The key to growing any church is retention of new attendees. This formula will help you work toward implementing a system that helps at least ¼ of the people who attend your church find a place to belong in a group or serving on a team.

COMMUNITY - THE 1 FOCUS PRINCIPLE

Community and care are crucial to the well-being of your church. We call this the 1 Focus Principle because the pastor's energy, the church's vision, and the church's assimilation process should have 1 focus—building community and care.

CARE - THE 7:100 RATIO

Building places of belonging is a challenging and important part of every pastor's job. This ratio points to a practical strategy for developing systems in your church that create structure for every 100 people into 7 smaller groups.

• MEASUREMENT - ATTENDANCE/FOLLOW-UP/CONNECTION

You can't manage what you don't measure. This final formula is designed to help you measure how effectively people are moving through your church's vision and process.
